## Supplies

**Stamps:** Home & Garden Bundle

**Inks:** Real Red, Memento Tuxedo Black, Garden Green, Soft Suede

**Blends:** Med 500, Real Red, Smoky Slate

**Paper:** *Real Red* 5 1/2" x 8 1/2"

*Basic Black* 4" X 5 1/4" (X2)

*Basic White* 3 3/4" x 5"

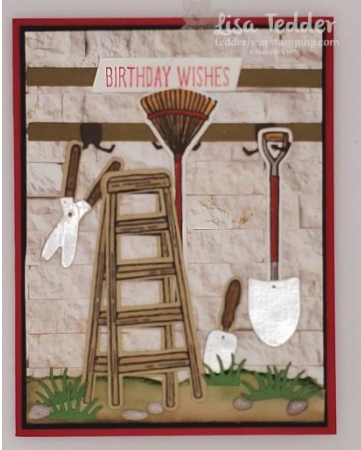
*Crumb Cake* 1" x 3 7/8"

*In Good Taste Designer* 3 7/8" x 5 1/8"

*Soft Suede/Early Espresso* scrap for wood beams/hangers

**Embellishments:** Pebbles Enamel Shapes

**Tools:** Stampin' Cut & Emboss machine, Dauber



## Birthday Wishes

1. Score Base @ 4 1/4", burnish with Bone Folder.
2. Layer Designer paper onto one Black piece. Adhere to front of card.
3. Stamp the hedge trimmer, rake, trowel, ladder (x2) and Shovel, Color using blends die cut out.
4. Die cut the two Beams from Soft Suede. Attach towards top of card.
5. Die cut the 'hangers' using Early Espresso scrap, attach to bottom wood beam. Now 'hang' your tools on them.
6. Tear Crumb Cake so it is uneven on the top, using a dauber go around the edges with Soft Suede. Then add in some Garden Green ink as shown. Before adhering to bottom have Trowel go just below the 'surface' of the ground.
7. Put the ladders together and place on front so it looks like it is open and resting on the ground.
8. Die cut the Grass so you have 6 clumps. 5 go on the front. Add Pebbles to front.
9. Stamp sentiment on inside using Memento Tuxedo black, die cut rocks at bottom left and add clump of grass. Adhere to last Black piece.
