Stamps: Flowing Flowers, Very

Versailles

Inks: Highland Heather, Soft

Sea Foam, Old Olive

Paper: Highland Heather 4 1/4" x

11", 1" x 5", scrap

Basic 4" x 5 1/4" (x2), 2 1/2" x 5",

scrap for sentiment

Embellishments: Glittered

ribbon,

Tools: Tasteful Textile 3D

Embossing Folder, Scalloped

Contours Dies

Flowing Flowers

- 1. Score base at 5 ½" fold and Burnish.
- 2. Die cut Highland Heather piece using the Scalloped Contours Dies, set aside.
- 3. Run one of the Basic White big pieces through machine using Tasteful Textile folder, adhere to base front.
- 4. With smaller White stamp small background words from Very Versailles on entire piece using Soft Sea Foam ink, stamp flowers using Highland Heather ink, and finally stamp leaves from Vey Versailles in areas you would like to fill in using Old Olive ink. Adhere scalloped piece from #2 below.
- 5. Wrap 19" of ribbon around stamped piece, tying a bow in left corner. Place Adhesive on back and place a little above center on front of card.
- 6. Stamp sentiment on small scrap of White, angle cut, place onto scrap of Highland Heather, cut to match. Place Dimensionals on back and apply over ribbon as shown.
- 7. Stamp inside White piece with Flower in corner and inside sentiment using Highland Heather. Place inside card.
