Stamps: Paradise Palms

Inks: Coastal Cabana, Bermuda Bay,

Crumb Cake, Balmy Blue

Stampin' Write Markers: Soft Suede, Garden Green, Granny Apple Green Paper: <u>Coastal Cabana</u> 4 1/4" x 11"

Basic White 4" x 5 1/4" (x2)

Tools: Blending Brush, Paper Snips

Scissors, Post-It tape

Happy Birthday

- 1. Score Base at 5 ½", fold & burnish.
- 2. Tear your Tape/Post-It down the center, with the top half, place towards the center of your Basic White, using a Blending Brush go over the bottom of the card using Crumb Cake ink.
- 3. Take bottom half of the tape, line up with the top half, then remove the top half and flip it so the flat edge is now facing towards the sand but a little higher. This is where you will use the Blending Brush with Coastal Cabana, once you have that, then go over THE TOP EDGE ONLY with Bermuda bay, to make the Horizon darker.
- 4. Remove all tape, and go over the sky with Balmy Blue ink and a Blending Brush.
- 5. Color the Three Palms stamp with the Markers listed, I colored the tops with Granny Apple Green, then went over one side of the Palm tops with Garden Green, this gives a two tone to them. Huff on stamp then place on left side as shown. While you have this stamp out, do the same for inside as shown.
- 6. For the two other trees, you will use some of the Tape to make the trees NOT as long as the stamp. Color in same way as step #5, but use both of the Tree bases so one is leaning.
- 7. Go over the base of the trees with a little more Crumb Cake/Brush to make it look shadowed.
- 8. Go over the entire stamped piece with your scissors along all the edges to make rough, adhere to Base.
- 9. Stamp inside sentiment using the Soft Suede Marker. Place inside card.
