



Supplies Stamps: Hello Ladybug Inks: Parakeet Party, Evening Evergreen Paper: <u>Basic White</u> 7" x 8 ½", 2 ¾" x 6 ¾" <u>Parakeet Party</u> 3 ½" x 8 ½" (x2), 3" x 7 ½" for leaves <u>Basic Black</u> scrap for bee <u>Hues of Happiness Designer</u> scrap for Ladybug wings Embellishments: Basic Rhinestones Tools Ladybug Builder punch, paper

## Hello

- 1. Score base at 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ , fold and burnish.
- 2. Using Parakeet Party ink stamp leaf all over one of the Parakeet Party cardstock you cut. I stamped off in picture, but you can stamp full strength tone on tone if you want the leaf background more pronounced.
- 3. On scrap Parakeet Party Stamp leaves in Evening Evergreen ink, fussy cut, set aside.
- 4. Punch all the bodies from Basic Black scrap, and wings from the Designer Paper, using Ladybug Builder punch, adhere together.
- 5. Place Rhinestones onto Ladybugs as shown, place dimensionals on back set aside.
- 6. Figure out where you want both the leaves and ladybugs, and before you adhere them, stamp 'hello' in Evening Evergreen ink in blank spaces. Now you can adhere the leaves flat and place the Ladybugs where desired.
- 7. Stamp Leaf image using Evening Evergreen on White cardstock, layer onto 2<sup>nd</sup> piece of Parakeet Party and then adhere to inside of card.
