Stamps: Paradise Palms

Inks: Blackberry Bliss, Poppy Parade, Daffodil Delight, White Craft Re-Inker,

Memento Tuxedo Black

Paper: <u>Blackberry Bliss</u> 5 ½" x 8 ½" <u>Basic White</u> 3 ¾" x 5" (x2), scrap for

sentiment

<u>Basic Black</u> 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (x2), scraps for

sentiment/Palm Dies

Tools: Double Oval Punch, Black & White Gingham ribbon, Palms Dies, Post-It tape,

Water Painter

Little Paradise

- 1. Using the Tape go up 2" from bottom and 1 1/4" from top, so only 1 3/4" is showing on Basic White piece.
- 2. Starting from the Bottom, divide the space by 3, and only ink with the Blending Brush the Daffodil at the bottom part. Then move on to Poppy Parade in middle, blending into last color. Lastly, use the Blackberry Bliss at the top, blend into the last, so it is a smooth transition.
- Squeeze out some White Craft re-inker onto a surface (I used a stamp block), then squeeze Water Painter until
 the tip is pretty wet, dip into the ink, and tap the Brush tip onto your finger holding it over the Blended sky to give
 some 'stars'. Let dry.
- 4. Remove Tape, Die cut the Palm from Basic Black cardstock. Place glue on back and place as shown on card.
- 5. Wrap the ribbon so it goes across to the back, adhere to the back. Adhere to one of the black Layers. Cut off some more ribbon and tie a knot onto the left side of the ribbon.
- Punch one Black scallop Oval and one White Oval using the Double Oval Punch. Stamp sentiment onto White using Memento Black ink. Adhere to the Black Scallop Oval, then place Dimensionals on back and straddle the ribbon on the front.
- 7. Die cut the Leaf from Basic Black paper and adhere to inside White piece.
- 8. Die cut Design from Basic Black paper and adhere to the top of inside piece.
- 9. Adhere White from step #8 to Basic Black layer, adhere to inside of card.
