Wishing You Happiness

- 1. Score Base at 4 1/4", fold and Burnish.
- 2. Stamp 2 3/4" x 4" piece of Basic White with the Sentiment at the bottom using Evening Evergreen ink.
- 3. Stamp on scrap the 'sea' in Pacific Point, then immediately go over with Water Painter to spread out the color. Die cut. set aside.
- 4. With a scrap of Expressions in Ink die cut 2 'grass' clumps, set aside.
- 5. On smaller scrap of Basic White die cut Fence, set aside.
- 6. Punch or use die to get a small Sun from Mango Melody scrap. Set aside.
- 7. Adhere Sun to back of Water, then adhere to middle of Basic White you stamped sentiment on.
- 8. Adhere Fence over water as shown.
- 9. Stagger the Grass and adhere to bottom of fence.
- 10. Stamp Birds at top of sky using Memento Black.
- 11. Adhere stamped piece off set to Black piece, then adhere to smaller piece of Pacific Point so White is straight and Black layer isn't. Then adhere these to one of your Basic White pieces, attach to front of card.
- 12. Add Pebbles as desired.
- 13. Stamp other Basic White Grass and Sentiment using the Evening Evergreen ink, adhere inside card.
