





**Supplies** 

Stamps: Heron Habitat

Inks: Pacific Point, Memento Tuxedo Black

Blends: Smoky Slate

Paper: Pacific Point 4 1/4" x 11"

Basic White: 3 3/4" x 5" (x2), 1" x 2 1/4" (scrap)

Soft Suede: 1 ½" x 2"

Tahitian Tide: ¾" x 5"

Old Olive: scrap for 'grass'

**Embellishments:** Linen Thread

**Tools:** Heron Dies, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Timber 3D embossing folder,

Blending Brush.

## **Enjoy Your Day**

- 1. Score your Base at 5 ½", fold & burnish.
- 2. Stamp Heron in 'sky' towards the top left side of Basic White, using Memento Black ink.
- 3. Make a Mask of the Heron from Post-It Removable Labeling Tape or Post-It note. Cover Heron, then go over the entire card front. Once done, remove Mask.
- 4. Using the Smoky Slate Blend, color in part of the white on the Heron.
- 5. Run your Soft Suede through machine using the Timber 3D folder, once out, trim to 1" x 2", rounding the top.
- 6. Wrap Linen Thread around #5 6 or 7 times as desired, adhere to back and place towards bottom right.
- 7. Run Old Olive through machine using the grass dies from bundle, set aside.
- 8. Using the Die from the set die cut the Tahitian Tide with the one that looks like water, adhere at bottom of Basic White cover the wood post at bottom.
- 9. Add Grass to side of Wood post.
- 10. Stamp sentiment onto White scrap using Memento ink and die cut. Place as shown with Dimensionals.
- 11. Stamp inside Basic White the sentiment using Memento ink and stamp other bird from set on bottom right, adhere to inside of card.
