


# Tedder Bear Stamping

## Supplies

**Stamps:** Heron Habitat

**Inks:** Balmy Blue, Memento Tuxedo Black, Basic Gray

**Blends:** Smoky Slate

**Markers:** Parakeet Party, Soft Suede, Balmy Blue

**Paper:** *Parakeet Party*: 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" (scrap)

*Basic Black* 4" x 5 1/4" (x2)

*Basic White*: 3 3/4" x 5" (x2)

**Embellishments:** Linen Thread

**Tools:** Heron Dies, Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine, Blending Brush.

## You're in my Thoughts

1. Score Base at 4 1/4", fold & burnish.
2. On one of your Basic White stamp Heron towards left side using Basic Gray ink. Color in using Blends.
3. Using the markers, 'color' the stamp that has the water and the grass, stamp right under the Heron.
4. Place tape or Post-It under the Heron across the cardstock and using the Blending Brush go over bottom of card with Balmy Blue ink. Remove tape.
5. Color stamp of cattails using Markers and place towards right side over the 'water' you did in step #4. Also stamp inside White as shown.
6. Using a lighter touch go over the 'sky' with the Blending Brush making it lighter than the water. No need to cover up the Heron since you are doing this lightly.
7. Stamp Birds in the sky as shown using Memento Black ink.
8. Die cut the 'grass' from scrap of Parakeet Party, place so the cattails show through as shown on front.
9. Stamp inside White with sentiment. Layer both front and inside White onto Black cardstock. For your front layers, with Linen Thread measure 3" (x2) place on top left corner, adhere to back. Tie a Bow and adhere to top of thread as shown.
10. Adhere both on front and inside.
