Stamps: Paper Pumpkin July 2022 -

Sending Good Thoughts

Inks: Bermuda Bay (included), Poppy

Parade

Paper: Basic White Thick 5 1/2" x 8 1/2", 5/8" x

3 ½", 3 ¾" x 5" <u>Vellum</u> 2" x 3"

Bermuda Bay 4 1/4" x 5 1/2", 4" X 5 1/4"

Tools: Stylus, Clear Embossing Powder,

Heat tool

Ship in a Bottle

- 1. Score Basic White Base at 4 1/4", Fold & Burnish.
- 2. Adhere the bigger Bermuda Bay to the front of the Base so it covers entire thing.
- 3. Take Bermuda Bay card with lines and layer onto the front of the Bermuda Bay.
- 4. Stamp Ship inside Boat using Bermuda Bay ink, so the bottom of the boat is in the water, and stamp it also on Vellum, pour Clear Embossing powder over and Heat until shiny with Heat tool. Trim the boat out with snips.
- 5. With a Stylus, turn Vellum over and gently go over the sails on the boat, eventually pushing a little harder until the sails are white and puffy on the front. Add Mini Dimensionals to the back inside of each sail, squeeze small dots of Liquid Glue everywhere the Dimensionals aren't. Remove backing from Dimensionals and line up to go over the boat you already stamped 'inside' the Bottle. Set Aside.
- 6. Stamp sentiment using Bermuda Bay ink onto strip of Basic White, trim right edge to make a flag.
- 7. Pop out the die cut from kit of the Coral, position on the card as shown, and use Liquid Glue to adhere.
- 8. Place Dimensionals onto back of Bottle and lay over the front of the card so it is also going over the Coral as shown.
- 9. Adhere the sentiment onto the front above the bottle and adhere flat.
- 10. Stamp inside piece of Basic White with the Coral stamp with Poppy Parade ink. Adhere onto Bermuda Bay cardstock and adhere inside card.
