





Supplies

Stamps: Caroling Mice, Brightest

Glow

Inks: Memento Tuxedo Black, Real Red, Starry Sky, White Re-inker Blends: Daffodil Delight, Real Red, Smoky Slate, Night of Navy, Soft Suede, Petal Pink, Basic Black (light)

Paper:

<u>Starry Sky</u> 4 ¼" x 11" <u>Basic White</u> 3 ¾" x 5" (x2) Real Red 3 7/8" x 5 1/8" (x2)

Tools: Blending Brush, Water Painter

Singing Mice

- 1. Score Starry Sky Base at 5 ½", fold and Burnish.
- 2. Stamp Mice in Middle of Basic White using Memento Black ink. Stamp Light to right of Mice. Also stamp on the piece of Basic White for the inside. Color all with Blends.
- 3. Make a mask for the Mice/Light by stamping on Post It notes or something similar, then cut out. Lay over the images being sure they are secure.
- 4. With Blending Brush from the top down, ink up Brush and only go down ¾" of the front, stopping before the bottom of their coats. You will want this somewhat dark, but not so dark you won't see the music notes. LEAVE MASK ON!
- 5. Stamp the Music Notes over the Mice.
- 6. With the masks still on, drip a little of the Craft White Re-Inker onto a block or similar surface, get wet with Water Painter, then tap the brush onto your finger over the masked images. Once dry, remove the masks.
- 7. Stamp inside sentiment using Real Red ink. Attach BOTH of your white pieces onto Real Red and attach them to front /inside.
