

Supplies Stamps: Sending Smiles Inks: Old Olive, Cherry Cobbler, Calypso Coral Paper: <u>Cherry Cobbler</u> 5 ½" x 8 ½", 4 ¼" x 5 1/2" <u>Basic White</u> 4" x 5 ¼", 1 ½" x 4" (scrap), 3 ¼" sq. (for circle), 1" x 3" (scrap for flowers) (scrap for sentiments) <u>Pretty Prints 12" x 12" Designer</u> 3 ¼" x 5 ½" Embellishments: Elegant Faceted Gems, White ¼" Crinkled Seam Binding Tools: Stylish Shapes Dies, Sending Dies

Sending Birthday Wishes

- 1. Score Cherry Cobbler base at 4 ¼", fold and Burnish.
- 2. Adhere the DSP to the 4 ¹/₄" x 5 ¹/₂" Cherry cobbler as shown. Wrap Ribbon around to the back, adhere. Place onto the front of the base.
- 3. Stamp 'Sending' onto scrap using Calypso Coral ink. Die cut, set aside.
- 4. Die cut Circle from Stylish Shapes Dies, Stamp two sets of leaves using Old Olive ink.
- 5. On scrap, ink up the flower using Calypso Coral, then do the Rock & Roll technique and ink up the edges only using Cherry Cobbler ink. Stamp the flower head using Cherry Cobbler, die cut both adhere to tops of flower using Dimensionals. Add Dimensionals on back of circle attach to card front.
- 6. Attach glue to only the part of 'Sending' that will be on top of circle, add Dimensionals to parts that are hanging off.
- 7. Stamp multiple sentiments using Cherry Cobbler ink, cut apart to have it read how you want. Attach to bottom of circle, add Dimensionals to the part hanging off.
- 8. On inside Basic White, stamp stem using Old Olive ink, and do the same with flower top as you did on step #5. Adhere inside card.
