Stamps: Sending Smiles, Very Best Occasions **Inks:** Mango Melody, Cajun Craze, Memento

Tuxedo Black

Paper: <u>Basic Black</u> 5 ½" x 8 ½", 3" x 4 ¼" (scrap)

<u>Basic White</u> 2 ½" x 4" (scrap) <u>Very Vanilla</u> 3 ½" X 4 ¾" <u>Cajun Craze</u> 3 ¾" x 5" (x2)

Embellishments: Brushed Brass Butterflies **Tools:** Painted Texture 3D Embossing Folder,

Blending Brush, Layering Circles Dies,

Stamparatus if desired, Stitched Rectangles Dies

Thinking of you

- 1. Score Basic Black Base at 4 1/4", fold & Burnish.
- 2. Run one Cajun Craze through the machine using the Painted Texture Folder, attach to front of card.
- 3. Run both Basic Black and Basic White through the machine using the Stitched Rectangles 4th and 5th from outside, set aside.
- 4. Die cut a circle 1 1/4" from Post It or Adhesive Sheets using Layering Circle Dies, set aside.
- 5. With a Blending Brush, go over entire White piece with Mango Melody ink, going back and forth, to look like sky. Adhere circle about mid-way as shown.
- 6. With a different Blending Brush go over the entire white in step #5 using Cajun Craze ink....again go side to side. Take off Circle and LIGHTLY go over sun to help blend in and look 'hazy'.
- 7. Stamp or use the Stamparatus to apply Cone flower using Tuxedo Black ink, go over as necessary to get a dark crisp image. Do the same for stem/leaves.
- 8. On front of card layer the two die cut pieces (black & flower image) as shown.
- 9. Stamp inside sentiment using Cajun Craze ink on Very Vanilla. Layer onto Cajun Craze and adhere inside card.
- 10. Add some Brushed Brass Butterflies on front as desired.
